If your child may need significant additional support to participate safely in a group setting (such as frequent redirection, ongoing behavioral support, or difficulty following directions), we kindly ask families to consider the needs of our staff and other campers before registering. This helps us maintain a fun, safe, and successful camp environment for all children.

Join us for a fun and skill-focused pre-competitive swim clinic designed to help swimmers build confidence and improve technique. Participants will work on all four competitive strokes: freestyle, backstroke, breaststroke, and butterfly, through structured drills and guided instruction.

Swimmers will be placed in the appropriate group based on experience:

Beginner: For swimmers learning stroke fundamentals and basic technique

Intermediate/Advanced: For swimmers looking to refine strokes, improve efficiency, and build stronger swim skills

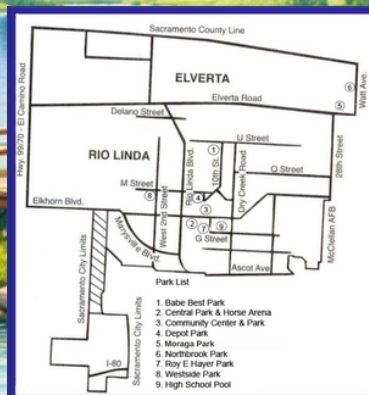
